Student Policy Compliance Agreement

California Theological Seminary is a spiritual training institution and a community of learning and godliness for a new generation of Christian leaders. Students are expected to faithfully observe and cooperate with the following regulations in order to cultivate a healthy academic and spiritual environment and to help establish the Seminary upon a firm foundation.

1. Students receiving scholarships must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.3 (B- average). Students who fail to participate in designated school activities (DSA) without a valid reason may lose their scholarship eligibility.
2. Students are permitted no more than two absences per course, including chapel and class attendance. Any additional absence may result in failure or cancellation of the course. Except in unavoidable circumstances, arriving more than five minutes late to chapel or class will be considered tardy. Two tardies shall be counted as one absence.
3. Students who withdraw from or take a leave of absence from the Seminary must pay all outstanding tuition and fees for courses previously taken before official transcripts or other academic documents can be issued.
4. Students who discontinue attending a course during the semester without notifying the Seminary will receive a grade of "F" for that course.
5. Course registration changes may be made within two weeks after the beginning of the semester. Any changes in registration must be reported to the Academic Office. The Seminary assumes no responsibility for academic problems resulting from unauthorized changes in course registration.
6. All enrolled students are required to faithfully attend weekly worship services at a local church. Any absence from worship services must be reported to the Seminary, and the student may be required to meet with the appropriate school official for counseling or guidance.
7. Students requesting a leave of absence must complete and submit the official Leave of Absence Request Form provided by the Seminary.
8. Students returning from a leave of absence must complete a re-admission interview prior to re-enrollment.
9. Conduct unbecoming of a theological student—including academic dishonesty, sexual misconduct, habitual borrowing of money from fellow students, slander, creating division, or forming factions—may be subject to disciplinary action.
10. Students are required to comply with all additional policies, rules, and regulations set forth in the Student Handbook and the Seminary Catalog.
